

Colours in Worship

This is just a guide and not definitive, any colour is open to different interpretation. God can reveal so much with what we use in our worship. So really open your heart as you step forward to worship.

Think more personally about what colours mean to you and why. Different feelings, circumstances and seasons can all affect your associations with a colour.

Remember flags and banners should not be picked up lightly. There is a lot more power in them, than people realise. They are vehicle to talk to God, to communicate, worship and share your heart. Be aware of this, as you choose to move with them.

Realise that God may have something He wants to communicate to you or through you when you move.

Overview of colour meanings

Red	-	Jesus Blood – forgiveness of sin, cleansing, healing, warfare, consuming fire
Gold	-	Kingship, glory, His holiness, liberty, authority
Silver	-	Redemption, word of God, wisdom, God's refining process
Amber	-	The glory and presence of God
Purple	-	Sovereignty of God, reigns over the earth, inheritance, authority
Orange	-	Fire of God, harvest, fruitfulness, warrior, Holy spirit
White	-	Purity, innocence, salvation, surrender to God, overcomer, Holy, undefiled, worth, honor, righteousness
Blue	-	Grace, mercy, the River of Life, revelation
Aqua	-	Knowing that God has the victory
Green	-	Healing, restoration, new beginnings, prosperity, throne room, flourishing
Pink	-	Faithfulness, humility, intimacy, child-like faith, first love
Lavender	-	Standing in His Presence
Yellow	-	Joy. Promises of God are true.
Rainbow	-	Gods promises, radiance of God
Black	-	Bondage, death to self, without light
